MINUTES

Bob Dalton **made a Motion** to dispense with the reading of the June 9, 2015 minutes. Bob McCue **seconded the Motion**. Bob McCue **made a Motion** to approve the June 9, 2015 minutes. Darren Frances **seconded the Motion. The Motion passed.**

POLICE REPORT

The June 2015 Oldham County police reports were emailed to city council members and discussed. Officer Moldero attended the meeting and discussed concerns with residents and council. He explained sometimes city ordinances for noise are better to enforce than state restrictions and funds collected for infractions go to the city which benefits the residents. Mayor asked whether increased patrols would be of benefit if Sheriff's Dept. was brought in to supplement. Officer Moldero agreed this would be helpful.

CITY ENGINEER

Mayor has received copies of 4 bids for pavement and sidewalk repairs from the City Engineer and best options were discussed. The City Engineer recommended in addition to selecting a primary contractor that a secondary contractor be named in the event that the primary is not able to complete the project to the standards specified in the bid documents. There was no discussion as to under what circumstances the primary contractor would be removed and the secondary contractor awarded the contract. Per bids received, City Engineer recommended Hall Contracting for primary contracting and Ohio Valley for secondary contracting for the paving contract. For the sidewalk contract, the City Engineer recommended Cline Construction for primary sidewalk contracting and Lawrence and Associates Concrete designs for secondary sidewalk contracting. Pricing for bids was discussed by city council.

Eric Vorseth made a Motion to approve Hall Contracting as primary pavement contractor and Ohio Valley Asphalt as secondary pavement contractor for the repaving of 3 streets within the corporate city limits – Sideoats Drive, Aristada Place and W. Orchard Grass Blvd from Sideoats to the city boundary. **Bob McCue seconded the Motion. The Motion Passed.**

Darren Frances made a Motion to approve Cline Construction as primary sidewalk contractor and Lawrence and Associates Concrete designs as secondary sidewalk contractor for the repair of various sidewalks within the corporate city limits in need of repair or replacement. April Phillips **seconded the Motion. The Motion Passed.**

NEW BUSINESS

Resident is requesting a No Outlet sign to deter unwanted traffic as Google Maps indicates there is an entry to Hwy 22 from her street when it is a dead end. Resident has contacted Google Maps to correct the error but if drivers have not updated their maps they will continue to make the same mistake. Mayor informed her that new signs for the city are being ordered and he will be investigating the proper regulations for installing signs. Resident also requests lines on the street indicating stop signs be painted on the ground.

Mayor praised Jackie Frances and her team for putting on another wonderful 4th of July Festival. There are areas of improvement and we may take a break from it next year. Much praise received for the fireworks display. Mayor also checked on the fireworks stand and everything was done according to the city's requirements.

Bob Dalton **made a Motion** for the meeting to be adjourned. Bob McCue **seconded the Motion. The Motion passed.** The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 p.m.
