POLICE REPORT

The December 2018 Oldham County Police report was distributed to the City Council via email and discussed. Officer Cornell summarized there were 8 courtesies, 10 citations were issued. Graham Village will have an officer living there. Most of the leases there will not be renewed as owner is renovating apartments.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer presented the January 8, 2019 Treasurer's Reports for review. City Treasurer also presented the preliminary July through December 2018 Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual Reports, and the December 2018 Disbursement Register. Bob McCue **made a Motion** to accept the Treasurer's Report ending December 31, 2018. Eric Vorseth **seconded the Motion**. **All were in favor. The Motion passed.**

The audit has been completed and she has a digital report. Auditor will give the F65 form with the state and provide her with the bound copies. City Treasurer is behind on property taxes due to recovering from illness.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mullins has been able to complete some projects. Cleared the ditch behind Plumwood Place. He also removed the tree fort and cleared the ditch line on W. Orchard Grass and creek area by Sideoats. He has also said that he will be working on clearing the Graham Village fence line over by Foxtail. Mayor is concerned about the tree on the Graham Village property side that might fall over to the city side. Owner of Graham Village needs to be given a certified letter by the adjacent property owner that the tree is in danger of falling on private property and liability will be on apartment complex owner.

Spoke to Mike at US Post about repair of the stop sign that was knocked down. Need a quote.

Bob McCue is working with LG&E to put 110 outlets at the city entrances. Will need a meter on each one. Permits required after LG&E does their part with the locator. Bob Dalton has repaired the solar lights at the entrances.

Drains on Bermuda Ct. are working well after the debris was cleared.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor would like some more décor at city entrances next Christmas. Bob McCue suggests doing some flowers at the entrances as well.

Rocky, the manager at the Marathon, wrote some in the city to inform them that he has removed the hookah pipes. Mayor will stop in to speak with him. Mayor will also stop in at the daycare to try and talk to the new owner of Cadence Academy to talk about paving. City Engineer mentioned Commonwealth Paving does parking lots.

Mayor would like to do a proclamation to declare a special day for Detective Mengedoht. Possible to add a second sign on Sideoats to honor her. Or rename Briar Hill Park after her. March 17th is on a Sunday.

Dave Mutchler is the former FOP president and liked the ideas the Mayor ran the ideas past him. City Attorney can help the Mayor put together a resolution.

Eric Vorseth **made a Motion** for the meeting to be adjourned. Bob McCue **seconded the Motion**. **All were in favor. The Motion passed.** The meeting was adjourned at 8:26 p.m.
